EVENT DESCRIPTION: Serial Robber Targeting Metrorail Riders

Campus police and security have received information about a serial robber who has targeted Metrorail riders. One victim boarded a northbound train from the University Metrorail station. The offender, whose picture and description appears below, sits next to passengers shortly before a stop, brandishes a firearm and demands property from his victims. If you see the subject avoid him, and call police immediately.

This information is being provided to help keep our communities informed and safe.



SUBJECT INFORMATION: Black Male, 6'0" to 6'2" tall, about 180 pounds, no facial hair, and has a short haircut. He has consistently worn dark suit pants and a vest (presumed to conceal a firearm). He has also worn a light tan sport jacket, as in the picture.

In an effort to prevent similar crimes the University Police Department recommends the following:

- If you see the subject on or near campus call 911.
- If you see the subject at other rail stops call 911 and/or report the subject to on duty security.
 - Avoid travelling alone on the transit system.

Anyone with information regarding this crime or information that may lead to the apprehension of this individual, is asked to call MDT DISPATCH CENTER (305-375-2700) or *Crimestoppers* at 305-471-TIPS (8477) where you will remain anonymous and become eligible for a cash reward.
