CRIME ALERT

Over the past seven days, there have been five vehicle burglaries reported in the 14th Street/Clinical Research Building Parking Garage and others in the Dominion Tower Parking Garage. In all instances, GPS devices and portable disc players left in a visible location in the vehicles were stolen. Vehicle burglaries also have been reported by local news media in areas surrounding the medical campus.

The Security Department is making every effort to identify and stop those responsible.

- Do NOT leave ANY property visible inside your parked vehicle
- Lock your vehicle
- Keep an eye out for suspicious activity, such as vehicles roaming garages without parking, parked vehicles with persons sitting inside for a lengthy period, and persons looking into parked vehicles
- Report all suspicious persons, vehicles or activity to Security at 305-243-6000
- Blue light phones are available in all University garages to alert Security quickly

Anyone with information regarding these crimes or information that may lead to the apprehension of the suspect(s) is asked to call **UM Security at 305-243-6000** or **Crimestoppers at 305-471-TIPS (8477)**, where you will remain anonymous and become eligible for a cash reward.
