Just before 2 a.m. today, a recently discharged Jackson Memorial Hospital patient was robbed at gunpoint in the Fred Cowell Mall between the Biomedical Research Building and Fox Research Building. The lone victim was chased into the mall from Bob Hope Road and hit on the head with a gun, receiving minor injuries.

The attacker was described as a black man about 5' 8" tall, weighing 150 pounds, with dreadlocks, last seen leaving campus in a late-model purple car, possibly a Chevrolet Monte Carlo. The Miami Police Department Robbery Division is investigating.

Although we have no reason to believe that any ongoing threat exists, it is a good reminder that we should always use the escort service when walking on campus alone at night.
