## **\*\*Tip of the Month\*\***

### **Beware: GPS Enabled Apps on Your Mobile Phone**

GPS enabled apps on mobile phones make it easy to share your fun adventures through social media.

Some apps let others know your general vicinity, while others allow you to virtually “check in” at your favorite places so that you can earn free merchandise.

Beware: this same information in the wrong hands can make you vulnerable to stalking, home burglary, or worse.

Take advantage of the privacy settings on these apps and only share your location with people that you know and trust.
